Day Center Host/Hostess

A warm, inviting person to greet guests when they arrive to CYO for services. Assists guest with access to computers, food, laundry, shower, phone, and case manager appointments. Answers phones and assists with administrative needs. Office Hours: Monday –Friday, 9 am. To 5 p.m.; Extended hours until 7 p.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Professional Services

Lawyers, Educators, Social Workers, Bankers, Financial Planners, Doctors, Nurses, Entrepreneurs, Counselors, Agriculturalist, etc. who would be able to teach a life skills class and/or be able to lend some services pro bono for some of our clients.

Artists

Local artists that would be able to come in on a rotational basis to teach a type of art/facilitate a demonstration for clients. Clients will then be equipped with the necessary supplies and be able to work on their project at the house on an ongoing basis.

Group Projects

Touch up paint in the house; Landscape services; create vegetable garden in the back yard; refinish front and back porches; create walkway from back of house to back yard; repair siding on the side of house

Driver

Transports clients to appointments, such as interviews, doctor, school, work, etc.

Vehicle

A vehicle donated to transport clients to various appointments.

Mentor

Spend a regular amount of time (to be determined) with a youth providing encouragement, support, social coaching and a sense of belonging with the end result leading to the youth's sense of efficacy, belonging and perseverance.

Donations:

Emergency clothes, sunscreen, bug repellent, blankets, towels, wash cloths, reusable water bottle, toothbrush/toothpaste, razor, soap, shampoo/conditioner, chap stick, small notebooks, pen, socks, hand sanitizer, healthy snacks (fruit cups, granola bars, etc.), deodorant, bandages, tylenol or ibuprofen, cologne or perfume, tampons and/or sanitary napkins, make-up, curling irons/flat irons, blow dryers, Payless gift cards, Target gift cards, WalMart gift card, adult bikes with locks, duffle bags, back packs, board games, dominoes, decks of cards, art supplies (paints, brushes, canvases, etc.)
