Dear Parents & Guardians,

Our Lady Star of the Sea School's first priority is the safety and well being of all of our students and community members. We review emergency procedures, attend trainings, and align practices with the Archdiocese, State, and emergency first responders. In case of an emergency on campus, we want our students to know what to expect, and how to prepare for a crisis should the need arise.

In order to enhance the safety of our students, we are preparing them by having Officer Durner of Calvert County Sheriff's Office read the ALICE Training Institute approved book, "*I'm not scared..I'm prepared*!" to our students. Officer Durner will come into the classrooms and read the story and we will help answer any questions the students may have about ALICE. The story is written in an age appropriate manner by Julia Cook and is available on ALICE training website www.Alicetraining.com. This book is used in all ADW schools, and approved by the National Center for Youth Issues and the U.S. Department of Education.

ALICE stands for: Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate. The story will be read to all classes over the next several days. Weather permitting, we will have an evacuation drill on Wed, May 15.

Please consider donating items to the Yard Sale to raise money for our school! Items may be dropped off in the Chesapeake Room.


