#### **Quarter Finals:**

Now I don't have a crystal ball, but there are some potentially interesting match ups in the next round:

**#1 Carmel** may see either #8 Westfield or #9 Zionsville. Carmel handled them both by 10 or more earlier in the season and they have the easiest path to the final 4, as the #1 seed should.

**#4 Culver** will likely see #5 Guerin Catholic, although I'm not ruling out #12 Bishop Chatard exactly. However, Guerin-Culver match up is very interesting. They did not play each other this year but stylistically I think they match up well. Guerin is a defensively stout team with a couple of exceptional defensemen and Culver's offense relies heavily on a couple players. If the match ups line up right this could be a really good game. They both have strong goaltending, as well. The edge may go to Culver at the faceoff x giving them the potential to control the game. But don't count out Guerin.

**#2 Cathedral** will see the winner of the St. Joseph's – Crown Point game. So the Irish will have to take on another northern team to make it to the Final 4 again. Cathedral already dispatched St. Joe on April 21, by a score of 16-5 and has not seen Crown Point. But the travel to Cathedral and the home field advantage may be too much for either of them.

**#3 Hamilton Southeastern** will likely see Brebeuf Jesuit. This may be a trap game for the HSE Royals. Hamilton Southeastern may be comfortable with their earlier victory over the Braves on May 11, 16-10. A confident Brebeuf team, coming off their overtime game with Culver may be peaking at the right time.

### FINAL FOUR:

Assuming the four top seeds make it that far, which is not a sure thing, the potential for a fantastic final four is in the making. Each of these teams has beaten each other with no game between them being more than a 2-goal differential. There was one overtime game and two others were decided within the last :05 seconds. In this particular incarnation of the IHSLA playoffs, the two lower seeds have already defeated the two higher seeds. So anyone can beat anyone on any given day. It's awesome!!

## Potential Semi-Final match ups:

**#1 Carmel Vs #4 Culver:** Culver won the regular season game, at Culver 17-15, on May 3. But you pick 'em.

**#2 Cathedral Vs. #3 Hamilton Southeastern:** The regular season match up between these two was probably one of the most exciting games I have ever seen in high school lacrosse.
