THURSDAY, OCTOBER 30TH

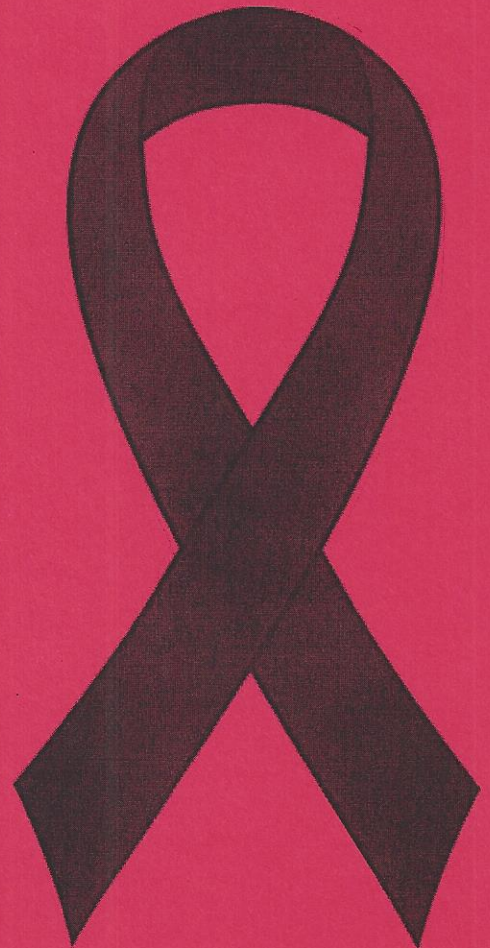

Dear Students and Parents,

It is that time of year again. The Young Authors contest for 2015 is beginning. Young Authors is a great way to show your child's work in creative writing. Last year we had three winners from our school at the county level, and two went to the state level for judging. It was such an awesome experience for our students and we'd love to have more represented from our school.

Below is some general information:

The contest is open to all students in grades Kindergarten through 12th grade. Fiction, nonfiction and poetry entries will be accepted. **The deadline for entries to reach me is February 6, 2015.** This will give the scorers time to score the entries and get them to the County committee by March 3, 2015.

I want to touch base on some of the common mistakes so that no entries will be disqualified.

- ✦ **Fiction/Nonfiction books may not exceed 4,000 words. If it is over 3,000 words a word count must accompany the entry.**
- ✦ **A book of poetry may either be an epic poem or a collection of five (exactly) poems, and must include a table of contents.**
- ✦ **A book of poems should not include the word poem in the title.**
- ✦ **An author's name should not appear on the book.**
- ✦ **All books should be in book form and no larger than 9" x 12".**
- ✦ **All books should have a front cover with a title, and a back cover, which is not part of the text.**
