## <u>Christ's Light Shines even through the Darkness of</u> <u>our World</u>

Like me, I'm sure many of you experience "death fatigue" from hearing about all the events around the world in which large numbers of people are killed through terrorist acts. Many young people were killed at an Ariana Grande concert in Manchester and a large number of Republicans were shot at by someone who did not agree with their viewpoint. People are letting their anger escalate to the point they must kill people they don't even know! ISIS considers any Christian evil and deserving of death. The man who shot at the Republicans tried to kill them just because they were Republicans!

People are killing strangers just because of what they believe. I am prolife, but I'm not going to go out and kill people who are "pro-choice" just because I don't agree with them!
