Ironwood Township Taxpayer

If you pay your taxes by mail, please enclose the payment stub or the parcel id number(s) with your payment. If you wish to receive a receipt, please send a self-addressed stamped envelope with payment. Payments must be postmarked by September 14, 2018 to avoid penalties. The July Board of Review will meet on Tuesday, July 17, 2018 at 4:30 p.m. in the Ironwood Township Office. This meeting is for errors and omissions, principal resident exemptions and to consider poverty exemptions.

Garbage

Please remember to have your garbage out by **7:00 a.m.** on your scheduled pickup day as per our garbage ordinance. Please bag all loose garbage for sanitary/ safety reasons or it will not be picked up. Also, the weekly limit is **TWO** cans or large bags. We do sell bags here if you have extra garbage; the bags are available at a cost of \$1.50 per bag. Recycling bins are available behind the Township Office for cardboard and paper only. **Please call the office or check on our website for any changes in garbage pickup dates during holiday weeks!**

Our Spring Cleanup was very successful again this year. Together we disposed of 20.73 tons of garbage, junk and a large quantity of scrap steel. Thanks to all of you who participated and who continually work to keep our township looking good! Our volunteer fire department also picked up trash along Lake Road this year. We will be discussing a fall cleanup date in September for anyone that was unable to make this one. Check with the office or website for that date **if approved** by the board.

Election News

The State Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, August 7, 2018 and the State General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2018. The State Election Registration Deadlines are: *July 9, 2018*-Last day to register for August primary and *Oct. 9, 2018*-Last day to register for November general election. Ambulance Service News

As you may know, Beacon Ambulance has served the residents of western Gogebic County for many years. In March of this year due to falling revenues and operating at a loss, they notified the County that they could no longer operate here. To avoid the possibility of not having ambulance service, all of the townships, cities, and the county have been meeting since then. Beacon allowed us to review their financial statements and their independent audits. Due to a number of factors including declining population, declining reimbursements for Medicare/Medicaid, increased costs for equipment, the lack of insurance coverage by patients, the operation was losing money. To avoid a crisis, we all agreed to contribute to the operation until January 2019. The amount needed was \$185,000. Gogebic County will contribute \$92,500 or half, and the other half will come from each governmental unit's share based on population. Ironwood Township will contribute \$13,850. The highest contribution will come from the City of Ironwood at \$33,860. The Gogebic County Board will be looking at a long term solution over the next couple of months.
