#### **RULES, REGUALTIONS & PROCEDURES**

#### 1. SCHOOLING & WARM-UP:

**Saturday (Hunter & Equitation Days):** The ring will be open for riding at 7:00 a.m. including schooling over fences. The ring will be open for schooling with appropriate ten minute sessions throughout the day, including over schooling over fences. No longing will be permitted after 6:30 a.m.

**Sunday (Jumper Days):** The ring will be open at 7:00 a.m. Flatwork will be allowed between classes. Warm-up jumps in the showring will be chosen as appropriate, either outdoors weather permitting or indoors as necessary according to footing and weather.

- 2. Post entries will be accepted at no charge, but pre-entries are MOST appreciated! Go to our website www.blackriverfarm.us, or www.ShowKnow.me to download our entry blank. Go to www.horseshowing.com to enter online, or email to: jackkate@aol.com or phone (908)-534-8833. SHOWDAY PHONE: (908)-800-3135
- 3. Black River Stables, Briarwood Farm, the property owners, lessees, or the show committee will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage occurring before, during or after the show.
- 4. The Show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or change any class(es) or schooling sessions as deemed necessary.
- 5. All riders must wear ASTM approved helmets, appropriate footwear and present a neat and appropriate appearance.
- 6. A \$15.00 EMT/Grounds fee will be charged to each entry.
- 7. All pets must be leashed.
- 8. It is a condition to entry to the showgrounds that these rules, regulations and procedures be read, understood and accepted. Management reserves the right to decline any entry deemed not in the best interest of the horse show or the horse show community.
- 9. Any check returned will be charged a \$40.00 processing fee.
- 10. Any entries or fees paid by credit card will be charged a \$5.00 processing fee.
- 11. All class fees are \$25.00 per class unless otherwise stated.

Riders need not be members of the M&S League to compete, but will need to be members to accrue points in the League.

#### LOW ADULT HUNTER DIVISION NJHSA - PEL - USHJA Outreach

Open to horses and ponies ridden by adult riders who are considered amateurs according to USEF rules. Rider may not cross enter into any class or division at the same show where the fences are 3' or higher. Fences 2'6".

#### PRE-CHILDREN'S EQUITATION DIVISION NJHSA - PEL - USHJA Outreach

Open to junior riders who are still eligible as Limit Equitation riders. Riders may not crossenter at the same show in the Children's Hunter, Pony Hunter or any class/division where fences exceed 2'9". If the division is split a rider may show in only one section at the show. Fences 2' for ponies, fences 2'6" for horses.

Rider may not cross enter into any other class at the same competition where the fences exceed 3'0" (exception: Children's/Adult Jumper, Pony Jumpers, USHJA National Hunter Derby and Equitation Classes where the fences do not exceed 3'6"). Fences 2' for small/medium ponies, 2'6" for large ponies, 3' for horses. (According to NJHSA rules, no NJHSA points will be awarded for this division at this UnRecognized Winter Series.)

A single class open to Junior Riders who have not won six first place ribbons in equitation with fences exceeding 2'9" as of December 1st of the current show year. Riders may not have won any equitation class at 3'6" or higher prior to December 1st of the current show year. To be shown over at least 8 fences at 3' with one change of direction, and it is recommended to include at least one combination. Optional Tests 1-7.

#### 30. NJPHA Children's Equitation/USHJA Outreach

A single class open to Junior Riders who have not won six first place ribbons as of Dec. 1 of the current show year. To be shown over at least 8 fences at 3' with one change of direction and at least one combination. Optional tests 1-7.

- 31. NJPHA Mini Medal/M&Ŝ Children's Medal/PEL- MiniMedal: Open to Junior Riders who have not won a blue ribbon in an USEF Medal, ASPCA Maclay or USET Talent Search Class prior to Dec. 1 of the current show year. To be shown over a course of at least 8 fences 3' to 3'3" with or without wings. Top four riders may be called back for a test. M&S Medal: 2' for small/medium ponies, 2'6" large ponies, top four to test.
- 32. NJHSA Mini Maclay A single class open to Junior Riders who have not won a first place in any equitation Medal Class where fences are 3'6" or higher prior to December 1st of the current show year. To be shown over a course of at least 8 fences 3' to 3'3" with or without wings, including a change of direction and at least one combination. A minimum of 12 riders, if available, to show on the flat. Flat phase to count 50%. Judged on hands, seat, guidance and control of the horse. One rider per horse. Mount must stay the same throughout the phases.

#### ELEMENTARY HORSEMANSHIP DIVISION ENTRY FEE: \$15.00 per class

A division designed to introduce the rider to the elementary aspects of horse showing. Open to all riders of any age who have not yet competed in any other classes at a horse show except Leadline or Walk-Trot. Neat and appropriate attire is required, including ASTM approved helmets and proper footwear, but formal attire is not required.

Open to riders 10 years of age or under as of December 1st of the current show year. Riders not to have shown over fences 2' or higher at a USEF Recognized show. Riders may not cross-enter into any other class or division at the same show where they are required to canter.




Ringoes is north of New Hope, PA and south of Flemington, NJ (near Mid-Atlantic Equine Hospital)

Memberships into the various points based programs are optional, but for most associations you must be a member to accrue points. Some are free to join, others have an annual fee. Be careful to note that each association has its own rules & regulations, and also its own qualifying period for collecting points. Specifications vary from group to group. Go to each association's website to get details. If you'd like further information, go to www.ShowKnow.me to learn more about what might fit for you. Ask at the show desk for details, then surf, learn, plan....then come horse show!
