**Qualifiers for BSPS Heritage Champs for M&M's, Show Ponies &
Show Hunter Ponies and The Showing Register**

RULES AND CONDITIONS

All Exhibitors entering shall be considered as having read the following Rules and Regulations. Anything not covered shall be decided by the Chairman and Committee in consultation with the BPS or with the Show Veterinary Surgeon in cases calling for their opinion.

- **JUDGES.** The Judges decisions are final. The Committee reserve the right to substitute any judge in the unlikely event of a cancellation. The Judges may withhold any prize where there is evident want of merit, where there is only one entry shown in a class, the Judges may award the first, second, third or fourth prize according to the merit of that entry.
- **CANCELLATION OF CLASSES.** Any class with insufficient entries may be amalgamated with a class of the same type.
- **OBJECTIONS.** Objections shall be made in writing with the objectors full name and address within one hour of the event concerned, and lodged at the Secretary's Office together with the sum of £15.00 deposit. The sum shall be returned if the objection is sustained, but if the objection is not sustained, the deposit will be forfeited to the funds of the NORTHERN ALL WELSH MEDAL SHOWS.
- **ENTRY FEES.** We very much regret that entry fees cannot be refunded, the only exception to this rule would be with a veterinary certificate stating that the horse or pony in question is unfit for competition, or if the show had to be cancelled for any unforeseen circumstances.
- **RULES IN GENERAL.** All Exhibitors, grooms and all other persons admitted to the Showground shall be subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Show. The Northern All Welsh Medal Shows will not be responsible in any way for any loss, damage or injury to animals, people and their property from any cause or circumstances whatever. Acceptance of the Rules and Regulations of the Northern All Welsh Medal Shows shall be a condition of entry.
- **ENTRIES.** All ponies must be registered with their respective breed societies and the registration number MUST be shown on the entry form. Registration number of DAMS AND SIRES MUST also be shown on the entry form. ANY ENTRIES NOT COMPLETE WILL BE RETURNED.
- **PARKING.** Wagons and cars must only be parked as instructed by the Stewards on duty, access roads must not be used for parking.
- **MEDICAL COVER.** All exhibitors are asked to include an additional £2.00 towards medical cover.
- **ENTRY FEE:** PRE ENTRY:£8.00 ENTRY ON THE DAY: £12.00

TSR Showing Finals - This show is a qualifier for the 2019 TSR Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals.

TSR Riders Finals – 1st & 2ndriders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals – The Two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the Judge/ Steward. Cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at: <http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk>

Qualifiers do not have to be Members of the NPS.

UNAFFILIATED CLASSES - JUDGE: Mr G Dunkley

Classes 1 – 4 are un-affiliated and are intended as warm up classes for true novice ponies coming out under saddle this season – please enter them in the spirit that they are intended.

- **Class 1 True Novice Lead rein**
Open to M&M ponies only. Riders not to have Attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Mare or gelding, 4 years and over not to exceed 122cms. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.
- **Class 2 True Novice First Ridden**
Open to M&M ponies only. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over.
Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a suitable bridle.
- **Class 3 True Novice Ridden Mountain & Moorland Small Breeds**
Confined Novice Mountain & Moorland pony registered in their respective pure bred society stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland Welsh Section A & B. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age.
- **Class 4 True Novice Ridden Mountain & Moorland Large Breeds**
Confined Novice Mountain & Moorland pony registered in their respective pure bred society stud books of Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest, Welsh Section C & D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old.. Rider any age.

BSPS AFFILIATED CLASSES - Heritage Qualification (Classes 5 to 15)

The 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners in the Novice Classes will qualify and in the MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE CLASSES the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th prize winners will qualify. In the Open Classes the three highest placed Restricted animals in each class will qualify, and in the MIXED HEIGHT OPEN CLASSES the four highest placed Restricted animals will qualify, (riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband).Restricted animals may also be placed in the overall class and qualify for both the Open and Restricted sections. Animals must be registered before the date of the show at which they qualify for the winter championships and must be ridden by B.S.P.S. Members, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies. ALL RULES AS PER THE CURRENT BSPS RULE AND SHOW HANDBOOK EXCEPT FOR ANY NEW OR AMENDED RULES AS INCLUDED IN THIS SCHEDULE. ALL PONIES MUST BE 4 YEARS OLD OR OVER. PONIES PLACED 1ST. NB. B.S.P.S RULES STATE THAT ALL NOVICES MUST BE SHOWN IN SUITABLE SNAFFLE BRIDLES.

M & M MINI CLASSES - Judge Mr G Dunkley

- **Class 5 BSPS Heritage Novice Lead Rein.**
Registered pure bred mare or gelding. 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st Jan in current year.
- **Class 6 BSPS Heritage Novice First Ridden.**
Registered pure bred mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st Jan in the current year.
- **Class 7 BSPS Heritage Open (restricted) Lead Rein.**
Registered pure bred mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st Jan in current year.

- **Class 8** **BSPS Heritage Open (restricted) First Ridden.**
Registered pure bred mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st Jan in the current year.

- **Class 9** **BSPS Heritage Novice Ridden.**
Registered pure bred Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, 4 years old or over. Riders any age.
- **Class 10** **BSPS Heritage Novice Ridden.**
Registered pure bred Welsh section A and B, 4 years old or over. Riders any age.
- **Class 11** **BSPS Heritage Novice Ridden.**
Registered pure bred Welsh section C and D, 4 years old or over. Riders any age.
- **Class 12** **BSPS Heritage Novice Ridden.**
Registered pure bred New Forest and Connemara, 4 years old or over. Riders any age.
- **Class 13** **BSPS Heritage Novice Ridden.**
Registered pure bred Fell, Highland, Dales, 4 years old or over. Riders any age.
- **Class 14** **BSPS Heritage Open (Restricted) Ridden small breeds**
- **Class 15** **BSPS Heritage Open (Restricted) Ridden large breeds**

- **Class 16** **Lead Rein SP/SHP or PB**
- **Class 17** **First ridden SP/SHP or PB**
- **Class 18** **SP/SHP or PB pony not exceeding 138cms**

- **Class 19** **SP/SHP or PB** pony exceeding 138cms

BSPS AFFILIATED CLASSES (Classes 20 – 29) - JUDGE: Mrs P Hollings

- The 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners in the Novice Classes will qualify and in the MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE CLASSES the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th prize winners will qualify. In the Open Classes the three highest placed Restricted animals in each class will qualify, and in the MIXED HEIGHT OPEN CLASSES the four highest placed Restricted animals will qualify, (riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband). Restricted animals may also be placed in the overall class and qualify for both the Open and Restricted sections. Animals must be registered before the date of the show at which they qualify for the winter championships and must be ridden by B.S.P.S. Members, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies.
- **Class 20** **BSPS Open/Restricted Lead Rein Show Pony**
4 yr old or over, not exceeding 122 cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained there 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year
- **Class 21** **BSPS Open/Restricted First Ridden Show Pony**
4 yr old or over, not exceeding 122 cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained there 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- **Class 22** **BSPS Open/Restricted Lead Rein Show Hunter Pony**
4 yr old or over , not exceeding 122 cms. Suitable to be ridden in the ring by a rider not to have attained there 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.
- **Class 23** **BSPS Open/Restricted First Ridden Show Hunter Pony**
4yr old or over, not exceeding 122 cms suitable to be ridden in the ring by a rider not to have attained there 10th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Supreme Championship 1st and 2nd prizewinners in Classes 20-23 to compete

- **Class 24** **BSPS Novice Mixed Height Show Pony**
not exceeding 148 cms riders must correct age for the type of pony that they ride
- **Class 25** **BSPS Open/Restricted Mixed Height Show Pony**
not exceeding 148 cms riders must correct age for the type of pony that they ride.
- **Class 26** **BSPS Novice Mixed Height Show Hunter Pony**
not exceeding 153 cms riders must correct age for the type of pony that they ride.
- **Class 27** **BSPS Open/Restricted Mixed Height Show Hunter Pony**
not exceeding 153 cms riders must correct age for the type of pony that they ride.
- **Class 28** **BSPS Open/Restricted Ridden Part Bred Pony**
stallion, mare or geldings, 4yr old or over not exceeding 148cms. Riders any age, with the exception of those riding stallions who must have attained there 14th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

- **Class 29** **BSPS Open/Restricted Ridden Part Bred Pony**
Stallion, mare or geldings, 4yr old or over exceeding 148 cms but NOT exceeding 158 cms. Riders any age, with the exception of those riding stallions who must have attained there 14th birthday Before the 1st January in the current year
