### Coaching

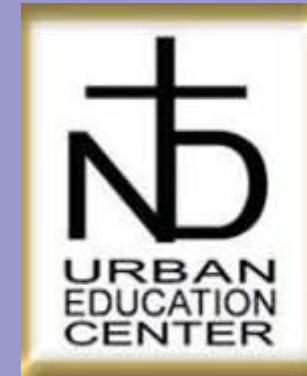
- ♥ Instruct and Assist with Exercise Activities
