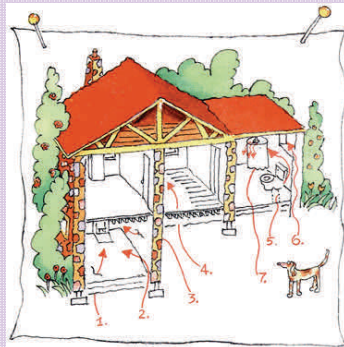




RADON:

Invisible Killer in Our Homes!

The Minnesota Department of Health recommends that every Minnesota home be tested for radon. It is estimated that 1 in 15 homes has a dangerous level of the cancer-causing radioactive gas! Free tests are available through your county.



Radon gets into our homes through:

1. Cracks in solid floors
2. Construction joints
3. Cracks in walls
4. Gaps in suspended floors
5. Gaps around service pipes
6. Cavities inside walls
7. The water supply
