REACH Alert Program

REACH Alert is a simple, web-based communication tool that allows the Board to easily reach the homeowners within seconds. Information can be tailored and shared with only those who need it. The Board will use REACH Alert to notify homeowners of any emergency situation. It is paid for by the Association and is designed to notify you by email, text alert, voice call to your land line or all of these. REACH Alert uses a simple 4 step registration process that takes about a minute to complete. There is no additional hardware or software needed, no "per message" fees and alerts will be sent quickly and accurately. **Information provided will be kept confidential, even from Board Members.**

Maintenance Update

We have contracted Greenscapes to use brine on the streets this winter similar to what is used on the highways to help keep the snow and ice under control. Brine is not applied when there is rain or ice. Reminder: the streets are not plowed until there is at least 3 inches of snow. Homeowners are responsible for their own driveways and sidewalks.

In the coming weeks we will be trimming trees and planting new shrubs.

Please remember while you're hosting those great holiday parties, there is no parking allowed on the streets or in the grass. Please do not park in front of the lift station. Please ask your guests to park at the church if there are no available parking spaces.

Please inform your visitors to park in a parking space, reserving handicap parking for our residents and visitors who need it. Owners who see vehicles parked on the streets may call A&A Towing and have the vehicles removed. Their phone number is **502-551-7651**. No charges will be billed to the homeowner placing the call to have the car towed. Also do not park past the sidewalk. Residents should be able to walk on the sidewalk and not have that area blocked by a car overhanging the parking space.

Reminder about Holiday Decorations

The hanging of seasonal or holiday decorations shall be allowed provided they are limited to entry doors, windows, balconies, decks, porches and patios and are removed within 15 days after the holiday has ended.
