Children are dismissed to the gym at 3:00, where they are checked in by a PTA volunteer and met by their PRIDE instructor. PRIDE classes conclude at 4:20. Pick up is at PRES. You will incur a late fee for pick-ups after 4:30.

Cancellations

PRIDE sessions follow the same schedule as the Bedford Central School District regarding holidays, school closings and delays due to inclement weather or unplanned events. If a class is cancelled a make-up will be held at the end of the session. A PRIDE member will contact you when the make-up has been scheduled.

Discipline

If a child does not behave, it becomes a distraction to the other students and diminishes the quality of the class.
