## 2020 SC Scale Model Mega-Show Update

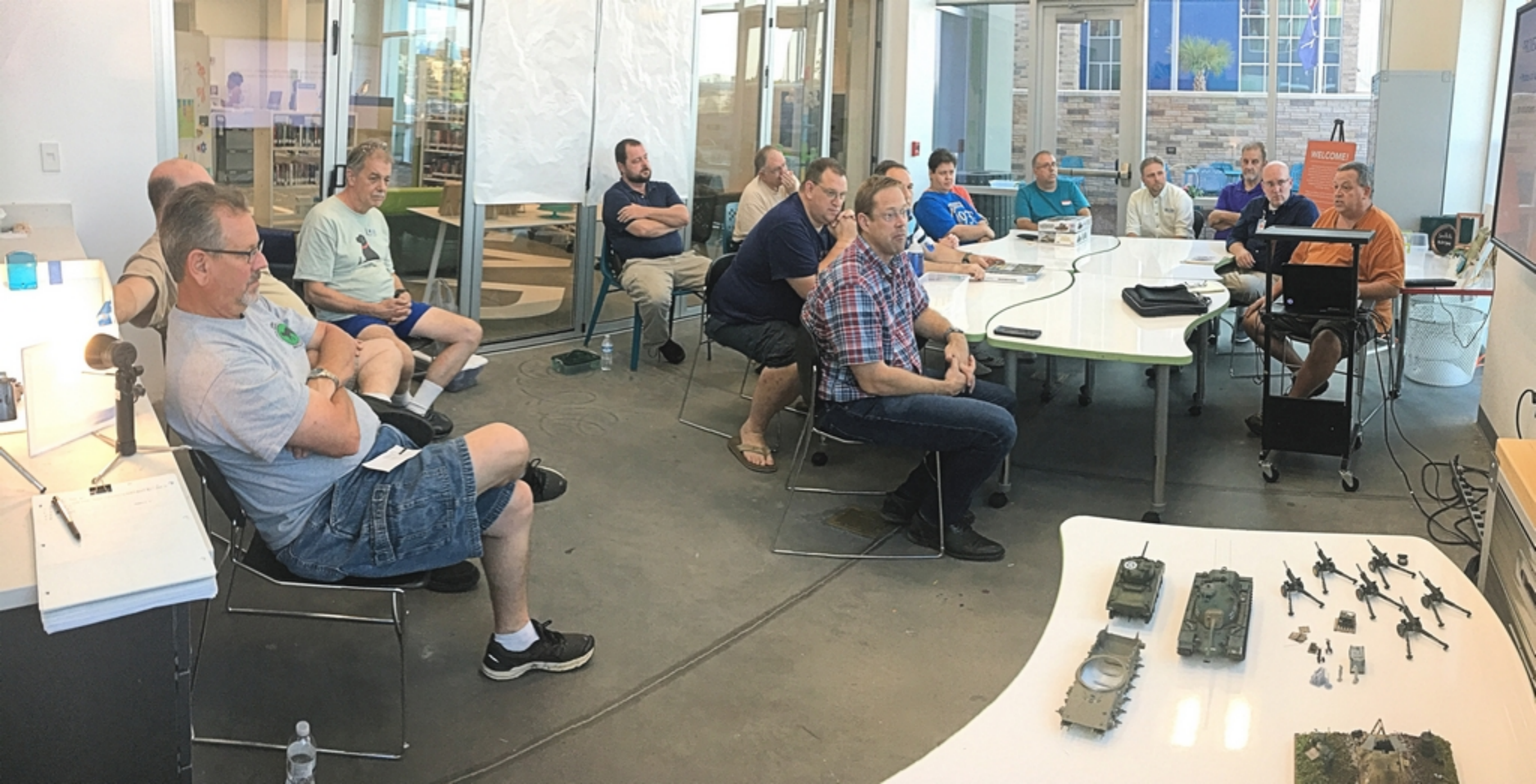
- IPMS Swamp Foxes voted to join us in 2020.

The side view of the howitzer at the top of the enlarged photo shows to good advantage the location of the speed shift, support between wheels at the center of gravity.

























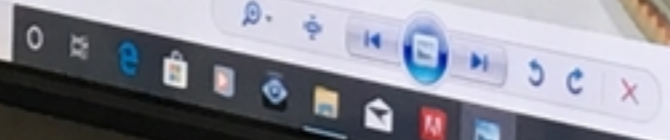
