TREASURER'S REPORT

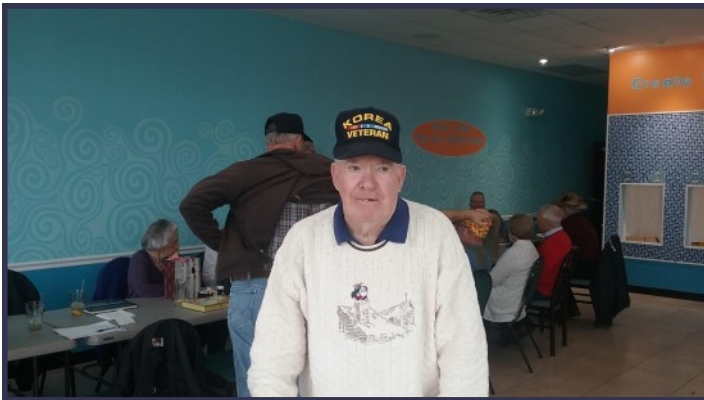

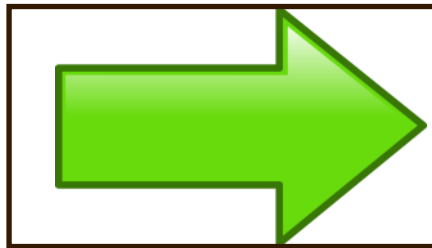

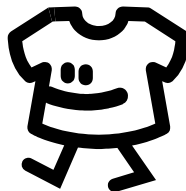
