Republicans just scored a surprise political victory in the reliable Democratic stronghold of Staunton, Virginia. Staunton is a city that voted for Barack Obama, twice, voted for Hillary Clinton and voted for Terry McAuliffe but is now controlled by Republicans. They have a conservative majority for the first time in recent memory.

Even more noteworthy is the fact all the Democrat incumbents outperformed their 2016 vote totals in their 2020 re-election races! Democrats got their voters out, but Republicans got a lot more of theirs out. It was noted Republican turnout was akin to a presidential or a gubernatorial year.
