**Confession of Sins ALL: Almighty and Everlasting Father, We come before you to seek your mercy and grace. We have sinned against you, and against others with wrong attitudes of selfishness and pride. We have not obeyed you completely and so have broken your Holy Law. Grant us forgiveness, for the sake of your Son, Jesus Christ our Lord. Create in us a clean heart, that we might serve you in righteousness and holiness. In Jesus’ Name, Amen.**

**First Lesson Exodus 32:7-20** **7** And the Lord said to Moses, "Go, get down! For your people whom you brought out of the land of Egypt have corrupted themselves.**8** They have turned aside quickly out of the way which I commanded them. They have made themselves a molded calf, and worshiped it and sacrificed to it, and said, 'This is your god, O Israel, that brought you out of the land of Egypt!' "**9** And the Lord said to Moses, "I have seen this people, and indeed it is a stiff-necked people!**10** Now therefore, let Me alone, that My wrath may burn hot against them and I may consume them. And I will make of you a great nation."**11** Then Moses pleaded with the Lord his God, and said: "Lord, why does Your wrath burn hot against Your

people whom You have brought out of the land of Egypt with great power and with a mighty hand?**12** Why should the Egyptians speak, and say, 'He brought them out to harm them, to kill them in the mountains, and to consume them from the face of the earth'? Turn from Your fierce wrath, and relent from this harm to Your people.**13** Remember Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, Your servants, to whom You swore by Your own self, and said to them, 'I will multiply your descendants as the stars of heaven; and all this land that I have spoken of I give to your descendants, and they shall inherit it forever.' "**14** So the Lord relented from the harm which He said He would do to His people.**15** And Moses turned and went down from the mountain, and the two tablets of the Testimony were in his hand. The tablets were written on both sides; on the one side and on the other they were written.

**16** Now the tablets were the work of God, and the writing was the writing of God engraved on the tablets.**17** And when Joshua heard the noise of the people as they shouted, he said to Moses, "There is a noise of war in the camp."**18** But he said: "It is not the noise of the shout of victory, Nor the noise of the cry of defeat, But the sound of singing I hear."**19** So it was, as soon as he came near the camp, that he saw the calf and the dancing. So Moses' anger became hot, and he cast the tablets out of his hands and broke them at the foot of the mountain.**20** Then he took the calf which they had made, burned it in the fire, and ground it to powder; and he scattered it on the water and made the children of Israel drink it.

**Second Lesson 1 Corinthians 10:12-13** **12** Therefore let him who thinks he stands take heed lest he fall.**13** No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.
