First I would like to thank everyone for their efforts in raising money for all our charities and the restocking of trout at Crowley Lake. Even with Covid-19 and only 84 Fishermen, this was truly another successful tournament year, thanks for all your help.

All of the proceeds from this year's raffle, the golf tournaments, and individual donations, will go to the Los Alamitos Historical Museum Association, Inc., the Ronald McDonald House, the American Heart Association, and the restocking of fish at Crowley Lake.

As you know, Shelli Appling does a tremendous amount of work for this Tournament. Because she is so active on the board of directors at the Los Alamitos Museum, I have decided to reward her by making this our main charity again this year.

Thanks to everyone's donations to the Crowley Lake Trout Stocking Program and the funds raised in our donation jar at the banquet, we have truly made a difference in the Rainbow and Brown Trout fishing at Crowley Lake.

For the past 22 years we have been stocking Alpers Trout before our tournament. With the help and support of John Fredrickson, Adam & Abbie Thomason & Crowley Lake Fish Camp we will purchase and stock \$5,000 worth of 3 to 5-pound Alpers Trout this year.

But far and beyond the call of duty and something every one of us should be extremely proud of, in the past 14 years we have planted over 50,000 Brown Trout-fingerlings, 3,000 Brown Trout-1 to 1½ pound, and 9,000 very large fingerling. With the help of John Frederickson (Crowley Lake Fish Camp) and the funds we raise, we will be stocking \$5,000 worth of Alpers Trout and hopefully some Brown Trout again this coming year if available.

Our ultimate goal will be to raise and plant 10,000 Brown Trout fingerlings in the fall each year, and of course plant large trout just before the tournament.

If we can get all of our Platinum, Gold, & Silver Sponsors to support us again this year and every fisherman commits to raising \$20 each, we will reach our goal of \$3,000. We fell short of this goal last year.

Now that John Fredrickson, Crowley Lake Fish Camp, has signed a 20 year lease, we have renewed our long-term support commitment with them. They treat us very well and really appreciate our business. Adam and Abbie Thomason are doing a fabulous job in operating the Fish Camp; we thank them.

I am very proud to be a part of this organization and the things we have accomplished. Our name has become very well known in the western states for our community and environmental efforts. We have set a tremendous precedent for other tournaments to follow by replacing far more fish then we take.

There are no other fishing tournaments, that I know of, that take 80 fish from a Lake in 2 days and put over 50,000 fish back in, as we did 12 years ago.

- \*\*Golf Thursday at Bishop Country Club \$90 (Includes Dinner)
- \*\*Clothing for sale: Hats \$15, Short Sleeve Shirts \$20, Long Sleeve Shirts \$25, Golf Shirts \$30, Sweatshirts \$35

### **2021 RULES**

- \*\* You will NOT be eligible for prize monies or trophies unless everyone you are fishing with is an "Entrant" in FATIT this year.
- \*\* All Trout will be classified as Rainbows, except Brown Trout.
- \*\* All Trout must be 2 1/2lbs and over for Rainbow & Brown's to count for money or trophies, both individual or team. (Except 15 and under youth award).
- \*\* <u>Two-Man Teams</u> Only 5 fish (meeting weight limits) will count for the two-man team totals each day. There is no reason to keep more then 5 fish per two-man team, except for individual awards.
- \*\*Three-Man Teams Only 8 fish (meeting weight limits) will count for three-man team totals each day. There is no reason to keep more then 8 fish per three-man team, except for individual awards.
- \*\*You can fish with any number of people in a boat and will be eligible for all prize monies and trophies, *except*, the team trophies will be limited to only those fishing 2 to a boat or 3 to a boat.
- \*\*You may still keep your limit (if you desire), but they will not count in the tournament if under tournament weight limit. A 2-pound Trout is approximately 17 to 18 inches long. A 2 1/2lb. Trout is approximately 19-20 inches long.
- \*\*These rules are great for most of you that love to catch and release, and for the people handling weigh-ins, as they now only have to weigh 30 to 40 fish a day.
- \*\*We will pass a money jug at the Banquet to raise money to help restock Crowley Lake. We will raise money for 3 to 5-pound Alpers to be planted just prior to our tournament and the remainder for brown trout to be planted in the fall. (if available)
- \*\*As in the past, the Tournament remains relatively rule free, except for the new weight limits, the obvious trout only-DFG legal, reasonably safe boating, etc. It's still just a fun tournament.
- \*\*You will <u>NOT</u> be eligible for Prize Monies or Trophies if you are on the lake or fishing prior to 6:00AM either day of the TOURNAMENT.
