



January 10, 2021 - COVID Update

Good afternoon from Midway Nursing Home

There are no new cases of COVID 19 for either residents or staff. There is one asymptomatic resident. One unit remains on precautionary isolation until January 21st. Use of full PPE per resident encounter remains in place as is close monitoring and limited movement of both residents and staff. We continue to follow all guidance and recommendations of NYSDOH.

Visitation remains on pause but virtual visits are encouraged and available every day through the Social Work and Recreation departments.

All packages for residents sent or dropped off in person continue to be sanitized and held for 24 hours before giving to our residents so please plan accordingly as this includes laundry being dropped off.

Regarding the COVID vaccine, CVS Health will return to our facility on January 20th to administer the 2nd doses and 1st doses for newly admitted residents and residents who have not yet received the vaccine. If you still need to give your consent for your loved one to receive the COVID vaccine, please call the facility as soon as possible to give your consent to a registered nurse.
