Kevin Biltz - Roads, Buildings, Cemetery and Park

--He and Scott patched pot holes. The roads are now in good shape.

--They went and looked at the beaver dam. It is very large. Jack Moss said he would trap them but the game warden cannot take the pelts until December 26. The game warden also said the dam should be broken apart soon so the beavers will be kept busy until they can be trapped. Kevin will check into a proper method to break it apart (explosives?). The water level on Stroup Road is getting worse. Diane stated that this is the property owner's problem and no more of the Township's funds should be used to deal with this. Diane will contact Chris Meduri to ask him for his opinion.

--He and Scott needed to remove a downed tree and they didn't have a big enough chain saw. He obtained prices to purchase a new one. He'll present them at a future meeting.

--He thanked the Trustees for purchasing the salt spreaders. The total purchase was around \$600.00. Tom said with selling the Township's unneeded equipment at the same time as purchasing the spreaders, the final tally was the Township was ahead by \$23.00. The electric spreader needs a wire harness. He will go to a dealer to make sure the right parts are ordered for it.

--Scott has his permit and will take his test for his CDL license.

--He plans to put posts in along the narrow roads (public and cemetery) to mark the edge for snow plowing. --He requested a new microwave for the garage. He priced one at \$59.00. Sandra will order a Township credit card for Kevin. Tim will get the microwave for them.

--He presented the bids for installing the electric at the garage. The three electricians who submitted them all used different specifications. Diane told him to go back to them with a set specification list and have them bid on the exact items. Kevin would like to see this installation completed in the spring.

--He'd like two garage door openers installed in the main garage and a new man door. He will gather prices to present at a future meeting.
