- The system was originally operating under a manual flow setting, following installation completion.
 - The communication wires from the old UV system were cut during installation, which is why the flow meter signal was interrupted.
 - The old communication wires were reused for signal to UV system for flow pacing. Flow pacing should result in energy savings.
- ➤ DEP grant program out now that could be used for stream bank stabilization that needs to be addressed.
- ➤ DEP Nonpoint Source Implementation Program Grants.
- ➤ 15% matching funds on some grants.

- Patteries dead, due to the extreme cold weather, on the main flow meter.
