Conducted by Joshua Sherman, the Horlick Symphonic Band will perform movements from *Carmina Burana*, German composer Carl Orff's epic cantata, inspired by 12th century medieval poetry, arranged for band by John Krance. *Rapids Drive Tango*, new music by Mark Eichner that incorporates melodies composed by Horlick band students, completes the program.

The Racine Concert Band, the official band of the City of Racine, will perform Farnham Festival Overture by Richard Rodney Bennett, and classical era band music by Joseph Haydn, the St. Anthony Divertimento. Conductor Mark Eichner, Music Director since 2002, will also lead the band in performances of Ottorino Respighi's only band work, the symphonic poem Huntingtower, and Malcolm Arnold's English Dances.

The bands will join forces for a grand finale, Gustav Holst's *Moorside March*, adapted from the brass band version by Gordon Jacob.
