Conducted by Joshua Sherman, the Horlick Symphonic Band will perform movements from *Carmina Burana*, German composer Carl Orff's epic cantata, inspired by 12<sup>th</sup> century medieval poetry, arranged for band by John Krance. *Rapids Drive Tango*, new music by Mark Eichner that incorporates melodies composed by Horlick band students, completes the program.

The Racine Concert Band, *the official band of the City of Racine*, will perform *Farnham Festival Overture* by Richard Rodney Bennett, and classical era band music by Joseph Haydn, the *St. Anthony Divertimento*. Conductor Mark Eichner, Music Director since 2002, will also lead the band in performances of Ottorino Respighi's only band work, the symphonic poem *Huntingtower*, and Malcolm Arnold's *English Dances*.

The bands will join forces for a grand finale, Gustav Holst's *Moorside March*, adapted from the brass band version by Gordon Jacob.
