There is currently funding available for the above. See below for eligibility.

**Criteria 1:** Low Income High fuel Costs (LIHC) fuel poverty data. Any household within an LSOA with fuel poverty levels above the Worcestershire average will be eligible. **See attached map – all households in areas coloured orange.** 

**Criteria 2:** Anyone who has qualified for a **previous heating scheme** listed below, or **disabled facilities grant** (all pre-qualified) or the **Connecting Families programme**, will automatically qualify.

Previous heating schemes:

**Bromsgrove Energy Efficiency Fund** 

Worcester Health Through Warmth Assistance

Criteria 3: Anyone over the age of 65 years old, a household with a child under the age of 5 years old or where householder is pregnant and with a household income below the Worcestershire average of £39,515 (gross) per annum.

Criteria 4: Private rented sector households in Worcestershire for insulation measures only

Criteria 5: A householder with an existing diagnosed health condition made worse by living in a cold home (such as a cardiovascular conditions, respiratory conditions,) and an EPC rating of E,F and G and/or an income of below the Worcestershire average household income of £39,515 (gross) per annum

**Criteria 6**; Any privately owned household with a **pre-payment meter**.

Criteria 7: Any ex social housing property sold into private ownership (right to buy properties)

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
