Ring 1 – All except classes 4 & 10 qualify Trailblazers 2022. Equifest qualifiers where stated.

CLASS 1: Best Conditioned Horse & Pony

CLASS 2: 3 Years & Under Young Stock

CLASS 3: Young Handler 12 Years & Under
6 to 12 years

CLASS 4: Senior Handlers (13 years and over)

CLASS 5: Veteran Horse & Pony 15 Years or Over

CLASS 6: In hand showing at any height
Open - Except to Stallions

Not before 10.30am:

CLASS 7 : EQUIFEST/SPILLERS MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND IN HAND/ Small

Breeds M&M Open to In Hand Mountain & Moorlands, must be registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies if wishing to qualify. (Exmoors, Shetlands, Dartmoors, Welsh A & B)

CLASS 8 : : EQUIFEST/SPILLERS MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND IN HAND/ Large

Breeds M&M Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, New Forest , Fell, Highland, Welsh C and D.

CLASS 9: Paints, Spots, Palominos, Duns & Roans BSPA / EQUIFEST IN HAND PIEBALD / SKEWBALD (Piebalds/Skewbalds only to qualify Equifest/ BSPA) The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championships. Subject to their show rules & conditions.

CLASS 10: Blacks, browns, bays, chestnuts & Greys

CLASS 11: Part Bred Horse or Pony

CLASS 12: In Hand Cobs (Traditional or Hogged)

CLASS 13: In Hand Foreign Breeds

CLASS 14: In Hand Sport Horse (Over 14.2hh)

IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES 1 - 14

Competitors finishing either 1st or 2nd are eligible for the championship

Ring 2 – All except classes 20 & 23 qualify Trailblazers 2022. Equifest qualifiers where stated.

RIDDEN CLASSES 15 – 25 Judge Mrs E. Biles Commencing at 9am

CLASS 15: Show Pony & Show Hunter Pony Lead Rein/ EQUIFEST JUNE TAYLOR SHOW PONY LEAD REIN/ SHOW HUNTER PONY- LEAD REIN Any height permitted to enter, qualification terms please refer to relevant organisation rules.

CLASS 16: First Ridden/THE COLES SHOW TEAM EQUIFEST SHOW PONIES FIRST RIDDEN
Any height permitted to enter, qualification terms please refer to relevant organisation rules.

CLASS 17: Equifest www.dufinkle.co.uk Ridden Show Ponies/ Ridden Show Hunter Ponies

CLASS 18: Novice Ridden Showing
Snaffle bridles only. For novice horses/ponies not to have been placed 1st in any open ridden showing competition. Canter optional in individual show.

CLASS 19: Ridden Veteran Horse or Pony 15 years and over

CLASS 20: Concours D'Elegance

CLASS 21: Retrained Racehorse

CLASS 22: Riding Horse/Hack/NUPAFEED/EQUIFEST RIDING HORSES/

CLASS 23: Ridden Sport Horse

CLASS 24: EQUIFEST Ridden Hunters/Ridden Small Hunters

Ridden hunter exceeding 153cm, small hunter to exceed 148cm not to exceed 153cm. To be split if entries warrant.

CLASS 25: Ridden Part Breds/ EQUIFEST RIDDEN PART BREDS

Exhibits wishing to qualify must be registered in the Part Bred section of their respective Breed Society.

RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES 15-25

Competitors finishing either 1st or 2nd are eligible for the championship

Ring 3 –All except classes 30, 31, 33 & 34 qualify Trailblazers 2022. Equifest qualifiers where stated.

RIDDEN CLASSES 26 – 36 Judge Mr A. Clayton Commencing at 9am

CLASS 26: Mountain & Moorland Lead Rein/THE BAYBUTT FAMILY EQUIFEST M&M Lead Rein Any height permitted to enter, qualification terms please refer to relevant organisation rules.

CLASS 27: Mountain & Moorland First Ridden/ EQUIFEST M&M First ridden Any height permitted to enter, qualification terms please refer to relevant organisation rules.

CLASS 28: CHRIS PIPER EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND / Small Breeds M&M open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Exmoors, Shetlands, Dartmoors, Welsh A & B. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age but to be suitably mounted.

CLASS 29: CHRIS PIPER EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND/ Large Breeds M&M Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, New Forest, Fell, Highland, Welsh C and D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over.

CLASS 30: Junior & Senior Equitation (Junior 16 years and under, Senior 17 years & over. Result will be split)
To be judged on the riders ability and the performance & presentation of the horse/pony,

CLASS 31: Riding Club Horse/Pony
Will be required to jump a small fence.

CLASS 32: Ridden Cobs (Traditional or Hogged) NUPAFEED / EQUIFEST RIDDEN COBS/ MAXI COBS Any height permitted to enter, qualification terms as follows: Equifest Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms/Maxi cobs exceeding 155cm. Trailblazers Open to any cobs (inc. maxi)

CLASS 33: Ridden Foreign Breeds

CLASS 34: Blacks, browns, bays, chestnuts & greys

CLASS 35: Ridden Coloureds & Odd coloureds, Spotted, Palominos, Duns & Roans (Traditional & Non) BSPA / EQUIFEST RIDDEN PIEBALD / SKEWBALD

The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championship. Subject to their show rules & conditions.

RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES 26-35

Competitors finishing either 1st or 2nd are eligible for the championship

Ring 4 –All except classes 37 & 43 - 46 qualify Trailblazers 2022. Equifest qualifiers where stated.

WORKING HUNTER CLASSES 37 – 47 Judge Mrs K. Coulson
Clear round 9 – 10am (£6, height may be adjusted)
Classes Commencing at 10am:

CLASS 37: Cradle Stakes – Lead rein permitted
Max. height fences crosspoles/40cm

CLASS 38: Nursery Stakes
Max. height fences 50cm

CLASS 39: Novice Working Hunter Pony/Trailblazers Sapphire
Not exceeding 148cms.
Max. Height fences 60cm

CLASS 40: OPEN WHP/KBIS/EQUIFEST WORKING HUNTER
PONIES/Trailblazers 148cm & Under Not exceeding 153cms.
Height of fences will be adjusted according to height section – up to 133cm/70cm, 133-143cm/75cm, 143-153cm/85cm. Rider to be the correct age for the animal they ride, please refer to Equifest rules.

CLASS 41: EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND WORKING HUNTER
PONIES (SMALL – UP TO 133CM)
Height of fences 65cm

CLASS 42: EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND WORKING HUNTER
PONIES (Large – Over 133CM)
Height of fences 75cm

CLASS 43: Novice Working Show Horse (Exceeding 148cm)
Max. Height of fences 60cm

CLASS 44: Open Working Show Horse (Exceeding 148cm)
Max. Height of fences 80cm

CLASS 45: Novice Working Hunter Horse (Exceeding 148cm)
Max. Height of fences 60cm

CLASS 46: Intermediate Working Hunter Horse (Exceeding 148cm)
Max. Height of fences 75cm

CLASS 47: Open Working Hunter Horse (Exceeding 148cm)/Equifest Open
Working Hunter /Trailblazers 148cm & Over Diamond
Max. Height of fences 85cm

RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES 37-47

Competitors finishing either 1st or 2nd are eligible for the championship

RULES

- 1) The Judge's decision is final. Objections must be made in writing within 30 minutes of an incident together with a deposit of £20.00 to be returned if the objection is upheld.
- 2) This Show is affiliated to Equifest 2022. The two highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.
- 3) Trailblazers – 1st – 4th in each class will qualify for the 2022 Championships at Stoneleigh – please collect confirmation letter from the Secretary.
- 4) All classes will be judged under and in accordance with the relevant ruling body.
- 5) Barleylands Equestrian Centre, the judges and officials will accept no responsibility for any loss or damage to belongings or to persons visiting the show
- 6) Properly fitting and secured hats conforming to the current british standards specification must be worn at all times whilst mounted at Barleylands Equestrian Centre
- 7) We reserve the right to refuse an entry, to cancel any shows or classes as we see fit and without giving a reason.
- 8) Entries received on show days, or after the closing date will not be refunded unless the organisers cancel the event or on production of a veterinary certificate.
- 9) In the interests of safety no dogs are allowed unless on a lead
- 10) No Lungeing of horses anywhere on the premises
- 11) No horse or pony is to be left unattended whilst tied outside. Should an accident occur or damage be caused you will be held liable.
- 12) It is a condition of entry that all competitors agree to abide by the rules of Barleylands Eq. Centre and to accept the **Disclaimer of Liability** as displayed on the premises
- 13) Payment of an admission charge shall be deemed to be an acceptance of the above rules.
