



Library Update

Hello again from Giles County Public Library. The holidays are right around the corner and we have been working hard to offer something for everyone, along with all the wonderful resources that are here in the library at all times. Let me update you on some of the things going on at the library that you may be interested in.

We restarted our **Ask a Librarian/Tech Help program** in October on Wednesdays. We have had every appointment filled so far. The program is every Wednesday. If you need tech help with your laptop, phone, tablet, email, etc., give the library a call, tell us what you need help with and get on the appointment list for Wednesdays.

As we celebrate **Veteran's Day, November 11th** here at the library, we will offer our veterans coffee and sweets and notes of appreciation. The white table display will be set up as a remembrance to service members held as prisoner of war or missing in action. We will also have a display, from kids to adult, non-fiction books about the military, of wars, biographies and autobiographies of people who have served our nation and protected our country.

We are trying out a new **STEM/STEAM Club** for teens on the third Thursday of each month in the library starting at 3:30. It is for ages 9-16. We have put together STEM kits for check out to parents and teachers. So we are now offering the STEM/STEAM Club here at the library and use the kits for teens that can come to the library. We will be able to do hands-on experiments and projects. This will be an extra opportunity, to learn and have fun, outside of school

Kanopy is coming soon to Giles County Public Library! We have decided to join **Kanopy PLUS** streaming service for libraries for our patrons. Our library patrons will be able to stream a curated selection of movies and TV series for free. We have chosen the category of Easy Watching to start. To access Kanopy from our library, you will have to go to Kanopy on the internet and find our library. Then you will need to put in your library card number and PIN/password. You can stream Kanopy from a variety of platforms: Desktop, Apple TV, cell phones (iOS and Android), tablets (iOS and Android), Chromecast, Samsung Smart TV, Roku, Fire TV, Fire Tablet, and Android TV. We are excited to be able to offer this service and we hope our patrons will take full advantage of it!

Caroline Bonner, a visual arts graduate from MTSU, has volunteered to teach **Art Classes**. We just had our first class and everyone had a great time learning and painting with watercolors. The next **Art Class** is set for Tuesday, December 6th at 5:30. It will be a Christmas theme and it will also be with watercolors. Please call the library and sign up if you would like to attend so that we will have enough supplies for everyone.

Christmas is around the corner, and that means it is time for the **Christmas Keepsake Plates** event. We are decorating Christmas Keepsake plates again this year on December 3rd with three sessions starting at 9:00 a.m. at the 4-H building behind the Extension office.
