I am grateful for that Sunday night. However, it only took a few more hours to be reminded that we still have plenty of troubles to address as a nation. But I have felt better in thinking about those challenges and the role I play in facing those difficulties. And while I am always grateful for my faith and the difference all the accompanying faith practices make in my life, I credit one two-hour comedy show – and some crazy good music, too – for lifting my spirits in just the way I needed right when I needed it.


