On February 2, exactly 40 days after Christmas, France and the world will celebrate La Chandeleur, at which time the French eat crepes and drink hard cider (cidre). Although considered a Catholic holiday, it actually derives from pagan rituals. This holiday is celebrated throughout France and is filled with traditional superstitions and proverbs.

In some regions, the superstition is that if you can carry the candle from church without it going out, then your household would survive the year, or that bewitched people could be cured by a candle from the altar plus other ingredients. Crepes carry their own superstition. Historically, if you either held a coin while flipping a crepe, or placed a coin on a crepe and later wrapped it in paper and placed it in a wardrobe, you would enjoy financial health for the year.

In the Vosges region, young women could determine who they would marry by throwing a handful of ashes on burning embers while reciting: "Chandeleur, Chandeleur... show me, while I sleep, the one I will spend my life with." I question if this is any less logical than the current practice of finding your life partner on a smart-phone app?

Speaking of romance, on February 14, much of the world will celebrate Valentine's Day – the celebration of Love. Although a global holiday, France and especially Paris are considered among the most romantic places in the world. In terms of expressions of love, Valentine's day in France is celebrated similarly to the rest of the world – cards, chocolates, roses, jewelry, romantic dinner, etc. Bonne Fête!
