PROGRESS CONTINUES TO BE MADE ON PRAYER SHRINE DEDICATED TO THE MYSTERIES OF THE ROSARY El Santuario de Los Pobladores – The Sanctuary of the Settlers, invite supporters of this undertaking to stop by the site to see the progress made. Adobe walls fashioned by hard work and zealous determination have gone up and completed. Adding additional warmth and appeal, a large beautiful rustic gate is adorning the entrance to the shrine with three smaller gates at the exits. Bronze art for the individual nichos has also been completed and will be mounted next spring.

At the entrance to the shrine, there will be a 7 foot bronze statue of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Seven surrounding bronze statues of our mission patron saints will bolster the spiritual presence of our faith. Adobe dedication plaques and merchant donor plaques will also be in place. Landscaping and a security system will complete the project. The committee estimates that additional funds to complete the project will be approximately \$250,000. MASS READING REFLECTION

June 19, 2022 Gn 14:18-20 [Blessing of Melchizedek]

It is not clear why Melchizedek is called "a priest of God Most High." The Letter to the Hebrews (Ch. 7) refers to this passage and sees Melchizedek as a priest, foreshadowing Jesus Christ, because he blessed Abraham. Church tradition, as reflected in the first Eucharistic Prayer, refers to the bread and wine offered by this mysterious King Priest.

It may be that Melchizedek had offered the gifts of bread and wine previously to God and gave them to Abraham as a sacrificial repast together with his blessing. As such, they could be types of the Eucharistic bread and wine, the Body and Blood of our Lord.

"Be pleased to look upon these offerings . . . and to accept them, as once you were pleased to accept the gifts of your servant Abel the just, the sacrifice of Abraham, our father in faith and the offering of your high priest Melchizedek" Eucharistic Prayer 1). Relate the Responsorial Psalm to our High Priest, Jesus Christ!* *

Second Reading— 1 Cor 11:23-26

The early Church celebrated the Eucharist as part of a communal meal, the "agape." Even today parish activities, picnics, and potluck dinners keep the members together and impart that feeling of belonging which we all need to persevere in the Christian way of life. However, in Corinth, it had gotten out of hand. The rich brought their own food and did not share it with those who had less or nothing. Hence, the meal, which should result in a closer oneness of Christians, became a means of division.

Referring to this abuse. Paul invites the Christians of Corinth to meditate on the real meaning of the Eucharist. Are you aware that your partaking in the Eucharistic Banquet signifies not only your oneness with the Host, Jesus Christ, but also your oneness with the guests at that banquet, your fellow parishioners?


