SWINE ARE THE ONLY ANIMALS THAT WILL BE STAYING OVERNIGHT

- Masks will be worn in any of the barns at all times.
- Exhibitors will wear masks in the show ring.
- Displays are not allowed.
- No Parking areas will be roped off and enforced.
- Shavings will <u>NOT</u> be supplied.
- No gate charge
- Social distancing will be required on the grounds and in the arena bleachers.
- All entries (including Showmanship) will be made on-line. <u>THERE WILL BE NO ENTRIES DAY OF SHOW.</u>

RULE 1. ELIGIBILITY: Participation in the Sheep Division is limited to members in good standing with their 4-H Club or FFA Chapter. Exhibitors must be enrolled in and attending, public or private elementary or secondary school or living in the Southwest Fair District area. Exhibitors may be ages 9-19 and may be in their first semester of college.

RULE 2. ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries will close at midnight September 15, 2020. Please bring your ShoWorks receipt with you. In all cases, the management reserves the right to accept or reject an application for entry.

RULE 5. Arrival will be the day of the show, Friday October 2nd. Registration and self-weights are from 8am-9am. Weights <u>MUST</u> be turned in by 9am. *IF YOU ARE NOT READY WHEN YOUR CLASS IS CALLED YOU WILL BE SCRATCHED!*

- **RULE 4**. RELEASE: You may leave as soon as you are done showing, premium checks will be mailed at a later date. Be sure to clean up after yourself and your animals. Failure to do so can cause your premium check to be held. NO SMOKING IN BARNS.
- **RULE 6**. Exhibitor must be able to have full control of animal or risk disqualification.
- **RULE 7**. Southwest Arkansas District Fair and officials shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage to property or the owners thereof.
- **RULE 9**. Only animals that are credible from the standpoint of type, quality and finish shall be eligible for judging. The judge may, at his/her discretion, award placing according to the animal's quality; therefore, a single entry is not automatically awarded first place.
- **RULE 11**. Any violation of these rules will cost a forfeiture of all premiums earned by the exhibitor. In the interest of improving the Junior Show, the Southwest District Fair requests that the County Agents, and Ag. teachers certify as to the eligibility of both the exhibitor and the animal.
- RULE 12. ALL PROTESTS SHALL BE MADE TO THE LIVESTOCK CHAIRMAN IN WRITING IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE CONCLUSION OF JUDGING. SUCH PROTESTS MUST STATE PLAINLY THE CAUSE OF COMPLAINT AND BE ACCOMPANIED BY \$100 DEPOSIT. JUDGING PROCEDURES WILL NOT BE INTERRUPTED FOR PROTEST INVESTIGATION. DECISIONS OF THE LIVESTOCK SHOW CHAIRMAN ARE FINAL, PENDING A COMPLETE INVESTIGATION.
- **RULE 9.** Showmanship classes will be judged after Dairy Goats. Classes: Ages 9-12, Ages 13-15, Ages 16-19. Exhibitors use their actual date of birth to determine which class to enter. **THIS YEAR YOU MUST REGISTER ONLINE FOR SHOWMANSHIP.** A \$5 entry fee must be paid upon entering ring the day of show. Money will be jackpotted; winner take all. Each exhibitor entering Showmanship must show his/her own animal.

MARKET LAMBS

- 1. Lambs must be entered by scrapie tag and have tags in one ear.
- 2. Health papers are required and will be checked.
- 3. Classes will be broken by weight and determined by show chairman. Weights must be turned in by 9am. If showing in the Arkansas Bred Show write the ABL tag number on the weight card.
- 4. Ewes shown in the market show are not eligible to show in breeding class.
- 5. Lambs must be owned by July 15th of current year.
- 6. All market lambs will be shown slick shorn. Wool longer than ¼ inch will not be allowed.
- 7. No ram lamb will be shown in this show.
- 8. \$5.00 of each entry fee will be placed in Jackpot and will be paid as follows: 60% Grand Champion 40% Reserve Champion
- 9. Limit three entries per exhibitor.

BREEDING SHEEP

- 1. All animals entered in the breeding classes must be registered in the exhibitor's name by July 15th of current year.
- 2. Registration certificates must be available for inspection at the show and the animals must be wearing the association ear tag.
- 3. Individuals in lamb classes must have lamb teeth and be born after September the previous year. Yearlings may have four permanent teeth.
- 4. No exhibitor may enter more than two entries per class.
- 5. No combination of junior exhibitors in filling group classes will be allowed.
- 6. Exhibitors are limited to three entries.
- 7. Animals shown in registered classes are not eligible to be entered in market classes.
