Show Rules

1.A **HEAVY DRAFT** is considered any of the following: Belgian, Shire, Percheron, Clydesdale, Brabant, American Cream, Spotted Draft and Suffolk.

1.A **LIGHT DRAFT** is considered any of the following: Haflinger, Gypsy (Cob, Vanner or Drum), Norwegian Fjord, American Draft Pony, American Sugarbush Harlequin Draft and Friesian.

2.**DRAFT CROSSES** are considered any draft breed crossed with a non-draft breed or two draft breeds crossed together that don't fit in any other category.

3.**MULE** divisions are open to mules.

5. Upon arriving at the facilities, all participants must check in to receive show schedule and stall assignments.

6. Each participant will be assigned one specific number. This will be used in the show arena and must be worn on the participants back. All premiums will be paid to the entry number.

7. Judge may consider personal appearance of exhibitor and hitch. It is recommended that all exhibitors have a clean and neat appearance when showing animals.

8. Exhibitors are encouraged to decorate their stalling area to promote a positive image of agriculture. Stalls and animals must be kept accessible to the public while the barn is open or as designated by the Superintendent. All waste, feed, manure, and trash should be disposed of properly.

9. Animals deemed uncontrollable and unsafe to exhibit will be dismissed from the show ring and/or the show grounds. The three strike rule is in effect if an animal gets away a total of three times in the show ring it will be dismissed. Show Management retains the right to warn the exhibitor and dismiss any animal deemed unsafe or uncontrollable at any time.

10. For safety, each wagon with 3 or more horses **MUST** have one additional person on the wagon, only one is allowed and no one may ride in the back of the wagon.

11.All exhibitors are strongly encouraged to display positive animal welfare practices while at the show. Show management reserves the right to disqualify and/or remove exhibitors/entries deemed to not be presenting positive animal welfare practices.

12. Extension Cords are permissible to use, but are not permitted to be in the aisles or in public areas where exhibitors or spectators can trip over them.

13. Harness boxes, feed, bedding and other show equipment which is used for the care of livestock must be kept neatly in the designated area and out of the public aisles.

14. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have entries ready to enter the show ring when show management calls for the class to enter the ring. Show management will determine the deadline for late arrivals. Classes will not be re-run for any animals missing a class.
15. Ages for horses and exhibitors are based on the age each animal and exhibitor will be as of January 1, 2019.
16. All horses entering the show grounds must have proof of current vaccinations for the year. These papers can be brought with you to the show or copied and mailed with your entry forms.
17. Out-of-state horses must have a health certificate and a negative Coggins test within the last 6 months.
18. The judge's decision is final. If you have a dispute regarding a decision, speak to show management and, if found to be valid, will be discussed with the judge on your behalf. Anyone found to be arguing directly with the judge(s) will be asked to leave the grounds.
19. Classes may be divided, combined, relocated or canceled at the discretion of show management.
20. Adds or scratches must be made in the show office prior to the start of the class.
21. Exhibitors may arrive Friday after 3pm.
22. A \$50 will be charged for all returned checks
