BRAINSTORMING ON PAIRINGS FOR SEATING IS CONSIDERING GROUPING COORDINATORS WHO HAVE HAD VENDOR ISSUE ACROSS STATE OE WILL GROUP PEOPLE BY REGION, THINKING AT DINNER TIME SIT WITH LIKE SOFTWARE OR CAD TO TALK ABOUT ISSUES YOU HAVE TO COMPARE NOTES. ng911 PROCESS. DEADLINE COMING UP. FINAL STAGES OF SELECTION ON NETWORK PROVIDER. TRAINING THIS IS REQUIRED BY HB 1590 4-6 WEEKS OUT TO CHOOSE VENDOR.
