Tucker County businessman honored for recycling efforts

The Recycling Coalition of West Virginia, in collaboration with the West Virginia Solid Waste Management Board and the state's 50 solid waste authorities, is honoring **Recycling Champions** who reach beyond their normal responsibilities to contribute time and service to support the recycling industry in the Mountain State. These Recycling Champions provide recycling leadership across the state and make a significant contribution to the recycling community.

The Coalition is proud to honor Tucker County businessman Stuart Thayer, owner of Sunrise Sanitation Services, Inc., who has been actively recycling for over 20 years. Thayer is the driving force behind the company's efforts to provide recycling throughout the rural county. Collection boxes are provided and serviced throughout the county and curbside service is available once a month for paper, cardboard, magazines, mixed metals and aluminum cans.

The commitment of Thayer and Sunrise Sanitation Services to Tucker and surrounding counties has been tremendous. Thayer will be honored beginning at 3 p.m. on April 19 in Davis during a meeting of the Tucker County Solid Waste Authority at the landfill office.
