# **Drivers Ed. Guide: Seven Steps to Teen Licensing**

- 1. Elite Classroom Instruction (32 Hours)
- 2. Teen Permit
- 3. Elite In-Car instruction (14 Hours) (create account on schedule2drive.com \$16.99)
- 4. Behind The Wheel with Parent (30 Hours / 10 Night)
- 5. ITTD Requirement (Free online video prior to road test)
- 6. Road Test Phase (Test with Elite or DPS)
- 7. Teen Provisional License Phase Until age 18

## 1. <u>Elite Classroom Instruction Stage</u>

- a. 32 Hours Classroom instruction \_\_\_\_\_
- b. Monday Friday, <u>6:30pm 8:30pm</u>
- c. Teens must follow classroom rules and complete classroom folder
- d. Absences
  - Only 5 absences & required makeup work.
  - If day 1-3 is missed make-up is Saturday \_\_\_\_\_\_ starting at 10am
- e. Remaining Balance
  - Students not paid in full by 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday will be terminated from the driving course

#### 2. Teen Obtain Teens Permit / Learner License

- a. Student eligible for Permit after:
  - TDE Course Fee Paid in full
  - Passed Road Rules & Signs Test
    - o Test given on the third day of the course
    - Students will retest on Fridays
- b. Submit the following to DPS for Permit/ Learner License:
  - DE-964 green certificate from Elite Driving School
  - Verification of Enrollment from Teen's high school or Parent if home schooled
  - Completed DL-14A for Texas Driver License (black ink only)
  - Identity verification
    - o (Birth certificate, social security card etc.)
  - Completed Texas Residency Affidavit with supporting documents:
    - o (Water/ Electric bill, Vehicle registration)

#### 3. Elite "14 hours In – Car" Instruction starts after Elite receives:

- a. Create online user account at <a href="www.schedule2drive.com">www.schedule2drive.com</a> for \$16.99 fee using school code C2702.
- b. Submit To Elite Driving School Office:
  - Texas Learner License / Permit
  - Driver Readiness Packet completed
- c. Schedule next week's sessions online every Tuesday at 6pm 8pm.
  - Students may do 1 drive time per 3 days, must wear tennis shoes & bring permit
  - Cancelation of drive time must be 24 hours prior or incur a no show fee of \$25

### 4. <u>Behind The Wheel with Parent & Licensing Phase</u>

- a. Teens are required to do 30 hours of driving at home with an Adult
  - Adult must be 21 or older with valid driver license and no restrictions
- b. 20 daytime hours/ 10 nighttime hours (Only one hour per day will count)

## 5. <u>Complete ITTD 2hr workshop (at Impact Texas Teen Drivers Website Online)</u>

- a. After FINISHING Drivers Ed
- b. Pick up license packet with green DE 964 two weeks after last drive session
- c. Create account Commercial Driving School, C2702
- d. Must be valid within 90 days of Road Test

#### 6. Schedule Road Test with Elite or DPS

- a. Schedule road test with elite at www.elitedriversed.com with the following:
  - Green DE 964 Certificate
  - ITTD Certificate
  - VOE from School
  - DL-14A
  - Birth Certificate & Social Security Card

# 7. <u>Teen Provisional License for Teens under age 18 (Graduated Driver Licensing Rules)</u>

- a. After Completing Drivers Ed, Parent BTW, 6 months wait & Passing Road Test
- b. May not operate a motor vehicle with the following:
  - more than one passenger in the vehicle under the age of 21 who is not a family member
  - between midnight and 5:00 a.m.
  - while using a wireless communication device
