### LUTHERDALE ANNUAL MEETING

On March 6<sup>th</sup>, Linda Hanson, Angie Lenzendorf, and Dave Hanson attended Lutherdale Bible Camp's annual meeting. The camp's new Hope Center is now open. Along with 20 guest rooms (for up to 6 people), the Hope Center has a large event/conference room, two smaller meeting rooms, laundry, and a hospitality center with fireplace.

Like everyone else during COVID, Lutherdale was forced to trim their budget, programs, and staff. But with the pandemic in decline, Lutherdale has seen a marked increase in reservations for 2022. Like most of us, Lutherdale staff see a brighter year ahead. With the new Hope Center, they are hosting a number of adult retreats, meetings, and conferences along with the kid/youth and family summer camps.

Budget-wise, Lutherdale's largest fundraiser is their Quilt Auction, which raised \$72,5771 last year. Along with more than 200 quilts up for bid, this annual event includes a silent auction, lunch, fish fry, and a fabric and craft sale. This year, Burke will be donating two quilts for Lutherdale's August 13<sup>th</sup> auction.

## FOOD PANTRY


