Helen C. Stoeckle, 102, of Sebewaing died early Monday morning, Feb. 28, 2000, at The Carriage House in Bay City following a three-year illness. She was born Dec. 31, 1898, in Hemlock, daughter of the late Frank and Pauline (Jubinski) Filipiak. She was married to Leon Czernik in 1916 in St. Charles. He died in 1948. She then married Henry Stoeckle in 1959 in Sebewaing. He preceded her in death on June 20, 1967.
