BILL WEBER HAS BEEN CREATING MURALS NATIONWIDE SINCE 1974. RANGING IN STYLE AND SIZE, HIS WORK INCLUDES THE “JAZZ” MURAL IN NORTH BEACH, SAN FRANCISCO ALONG WITH SMALLER MUSEUM PIECES. HIS PERSONAL SURREALIST WORK AND HIS MURAL PROJECTS REFLECT WEBER’S ABILITY TO PRODUCE INNOVATIVE AND UNIQUE IMAGERY AND CONCEPTS.

THROUGH BILL’S CONNECTIONS IN THE ART WORLD, AS CURATOR OF THE CITY’S EARLIER ART GALLERY, HE BROUGHT TO OUR CITY THE WORKS OF SUCH NOTABLES AS DIEGO RIVERA, FRANK LLOYD WRIGHT, LAWERENCE FERLINGHETTI, STANLEY MOUSE AND DONATED HIS TIME AND ENERGY TO STAGE THE ANNUAL BRENTWOOD STUDENT ART SHOW.

BILL WAS COMMISSIONED BY THE CITY TO CREATE THE BRONZE STATUE OF A FARMER SOWING SEEDS, DEPICTING THE ORIGINS OF BRENTWOOD, WHICH GRACES THE ENTRANCE TO THE BRENTWOOD CITY PARK.
