## MUSTANG VILLAGE MARKETPLACE GRAND OPENING THIS WEEK

Stepping Stones Academy announces its Grand Opening of the Mustang Village Marketplace occurring this week on Tuesday, November $28^{\text {th }}$ and Wednesday, November 29 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ from 2:10-2:45 p.m. Half of the students will shop on Tuesday and the other half will shop on Wednesday. Parents wishing to shop at Mustang Village are asked to stop in the School Office to sign in and receive micro dollars. A business owner or manager is required to submit a business plan to the Mustang Government before opening. The government officials then issue the business owner/manager a business license once all guidelines are met. The business license must be displayed during Marketplaces. Many business owners/managers also made appointments at the Mustang Bank to apply for a business loan so they were able to pay employees and purchase supplies before selling products.
Before Thanksgiving Break the Mustang Government announced its tax rate for this year. Citizens pay $\$ 10$ micros per month and business taxes are $\$ 20$ micros
 per month. Minimum wage remains at $\$ 10$ micros per day.
Mustang Village will be closed during December due to preparations for Winter Festival. Businesses will resume again in January.
