JANUARY REFLECTION

Revelation 21:5 "And the one [God] who was seated on the throne said, 'See I am making all things new.' Also he said, 'Write this, for these words are trustworthy and true.'"

Welcome to 2020, we finally made it! The New Year is always a reason for celebration. For many of us it is welcomed as a chance to start fresh, a way to begin with a clean slate. Yet, we have to wonder why we wait for January 1st to begin the process of self-transformation. Many of us have made New Year's resolutions, while statistics tell us that 95% of all resolutions fail within the first month, yet every year we talk about the things that we are going to do to improve our lives with the advent of the New Year.

The book of Revelation scares me.
