General Guidelines

- Contents must fit in bins with the lid closed. If items don't fit in the carts with the lid closed, you can either save those items for the next pick up day, or bring them to the transfer site (fees may apply).
- Items in the Black Cart must be bagged
- Items in the Blue Cart must be loose (with the exception of shredded paper or plastic film/bags)
- Items in the Green Cart may be loose or bagged in compostable bags
- Report damaged or missing carts at www.rockyview.ca/LangdonWaste

Transfer Site

When you have materials that can't be disposed of in the carts, take them to the Langdon transfer site (505 Railway Avenue, fees may apply), Wednesdays from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m. and Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.



Placement of Carts

Carts should be placed on the street no earlier than 6 p.m. the evening before and no later than 7 a.m. the day of collection (Green Carts on Tuesdays, Blue and Black Carts on Thursdays). Carts must be off the street within 18 hours after collection.

Use the chart below to help you place your carts correctly.

Blue Carts - clean, dry materials, free of debris

Cardboard

Metal



Acceptable

Flattened and broken down, coffee cup sleeves, cereal boxes

Not acceptable

Greasy contaminated cardboards

Acceptable

Aluminum foil, pie plates, tin cans; rinsed, with labels removed

Not acceptable

Aerosol cans

Mixed paper



Acceptable

Egg cartons (paper), shredded paper (in a clear plastic bag), envelops, magazines, newspaper and inserts

Not acceptable

Loose shredded paper, composite materials (items with two materials, such as cardboard coffee cans with metal rims and bottoms)

Glass



Plastic



Acceptable

Clear, clean glass, with labels removed

Not acceptable

Mirrors, perfume bottles, coloured glass, ceramics, lightbulbs, Pyrex, windshields

Acceptable

Rigid plastic containers such as those used for laundry detergent, dish soap, yogurt, and other food containers, plastic film (bagged)

Not acceptable

Polystyrene, household hazardous waste containers, single cup coffee pods or cups, toys, pens, straws, laundry baskets, potato chip or cereal bags, plastic cutlery

Refundable containers



Acceptable

Best to take those to the bottle depot but are accepted in the cart.

Green Carts - organic materials

Food scraps



Acceptable

Table scraps, meat, fish, chicken, bones, baked goods, bread, pasta, grains, rice, fruits and vegetables, oils, grease, sauces, salad dressings, jams, dairy products, eggs, eggshells, coffee grounds and filters, nuts, seeds

Yard Waste Acceptable



Grass clippings, leaves, branches up to a 2.5 cm (1") diameter, wood shavings/sawdust

Not acceptable

Dirt, topsoil, weeds, sod, cat or dog waste, diapers

Paper food containers



Acceptable

Soiled paper plates, cups, napkins, paper towels, cardboard and non-waxed fast food containers, coffee filters, tea bags, compostable coffee pods

Not acceptable

Fountain drink cups, coffee cups, and ice cream containers as these have a waxy liner

NOTE: outdated or unused medications as well as sharps can be dropped off at pharmacies for special disposal

Black Carts - household garbage



Acceptable

Bagged household garbage, pet waste, diapers

Not acceptable

Grass and yard waste, household hazardous waste, flammable or combustible materials

Transfer Site - these items can be taken to the Langdon transfer site

- Household hazardous waste
- Sharp items unless properly contained in a puncture resistant receptacle or packaging before being placed in your black cart
- Flammable, combustible or oxidizing materials waste motor oil, oil filters, or oil containers
- Tires

- Trees, tree stumps, logs, landclearing debris, timber and fence posts more than 100 mm in diameter
- Small amounts of home renovation waste
- Batteries
- Clothing donations
- Extra leaf and yard waste

- Lightbulbs including fluorescent tubes
- Appliances
- Christmas trees
