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#### What is a Literacy Tool Kit?

Literacy Tool "Thinking" Kits are just simply a way for students to organize their READING and WRITING tools that they use during their instructional day.

Each tool MUST be modeled again and again to ensure success!



#### What goes into the Tool Kit?

The tools in the "Thinking Tool Kit" are all based on extending individual students' awareness of the fact that READING and WRITING are THINKING.

# What goes into the Literacy Tool Kit?

Questioning / Making Connections / Visualizing / Inferencing / Noticing the Author / Noticing the Author / Summarizing & Synthesizing / Using Fix-Up Strategies







For Use By Student during Independent Reading, Guided Reading, Book Club discussions, and any other time appropriate to define the elements of FICTION and NONFICTION




