

Basic Sloper (Moulage)- 11 hours -\$250

Class Requirements: Intermediate to advanced garment sewing skills. Drafting experience is helpful, but not needed. There will be little to no homework.

Class includes: a book on CD (The Moulage) by Kenneth King, drafting paper, muslin, and use of drafting tools, if needed.

Class Description: This is primarily a drafting class. A series of specific measurements are taken of each student. Each student will then use her (or his) own measurements to draft a Moulage, or a “Second Skin” of them self. The draft is then transferred to muslin, sewn together, and tried on. The fit is perfected by the instructor. Any minor alterations will be made to the original draft, then basic slopers/patterns for blouses/ dresses and jackets will be drafted. Skirts made from the Moulage will be discussed. Dart manipulation theory is explained and demonstrated. The last day will include hands-on instruction on using your basic slopers to alter commercial patterns, or to draft and design your own. Drafting methods apply to fitting others.
