This course offers participants insight into, and practical experience with, emergency management operations and decision-making skills necessary to work effectively in an EOC. This course will also introduce participants to the support the Incident Command System (ICS). The course offers the opportunity for participants to practice emergency management skills and to gain practical experience. Each participant will gain a better understanding of the crisis management and skills necessary to effectively coordinate support for any type of event.
