### WHO WAS KELLIE THOMPSON SHILEY?

Kellie was a local star athlete and community role model who grew up in Annapolis, MD and moved to the Eastern Shore after high school. She attended St. Mary's School for 12 years where she excelled both in the classroom and on the field. She graduated third in her class from St. Mary's. She was a three-sport star and captained the 1997 AIS "A" league lacrosse championship team. In 1998 she earned the *The Capital's* Player of the Year award, first team All County, All Metro honors, and the Heather Leigh Albert Award as the top player in the Schoolgirls Division at the US Lacrosse Women's National Tournament.

Her exceptional high school lacrosse career propelled her to the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill where she continued to excel, earning All American recognition her sophomore, junior and senior years. In 2001, she was a finalist for the distinguished Tewaaraton Trophy for the top college female lacrosse player.

Kellie always excelled in the classroom. At UNC, she was on the ACC Academic Honor Roll all four years and graduated with a degree in business from the distinguished University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill Kenan Flagler School of Business. She was most recently employed by Pfizer.

Most importantly, Kellie was a loyal wife, mother, sister, daughter, and friend. She married Ryan Shiley on September 29th, 2007. In 2010, they were thrilled to welcome their son Landon into the world. In July of 2012 at the age of 31, Kellie tragically passed away from complications relating to the birth of their twin newborn girls.
