Joy to the World

Joy to the world, the Lord is come! Let earth receive her King; Let every heart prepare Him room, And heaven and nature sing.

Joy to the earth, the Savior reigns! Let men their songs employ, While fields and floods, rocks, hills and plains Repeat the sounding joy. No more let sins and sorrows grow Nor thorns infest the ground; He comes to make His blessings flow Far as the curse is found.

He rules the world with truth and grace And makes the nations prove The glories of His righteousness And wonders of His love.

Real Joy

"Shout for joy to the Lord, all the earth, burst into jubilant song with music." Psalm 98:4



There was a young man who was very unhappy with the manner in which the Psalms were being sung in his church. One Sunday, after coming home from church, he complained to his father about the congregation's use of the Psalms and the congregational singing of hymns. His father turned to his son and challenged him: "Well then, young man, why don't you give us something better to sing?"

Isaac Watts was determined to do something about his father's challenge. That very week in 1719, he worked on his music and one of his first hymns was sung by the congregation in the following Sunday's service. The response of the people to the song was encouraging. It led Isaac to continue writing hymns and paraphrases of the Psalms. It was a joy for him to write hymns. During his lifetime, he wrote over 600 of them.

Is there joy in your heart and mind during the Christmas season? I'm sure there is, but on what is that joy based? True joy and jubilant song, as our text speaks of it, must spring from the real joy of Christmas. That joy is that the Lord is come. Jesus comes as a King to rule in your heart and mind. Does he rule in your heart, or is he shoved aside for Christmas gifts and parties? Is there still room in your heart for him after all the preparations, buying, and celebrating is completed? Does he rule your life after the Christmas season is over? If not, make room for him and experience the real joy of Christmas.

What is this joy at Christmas all about? There is joy because "the Lord is come." Jesus came as our Savior. He came to save sinners from the punishment they deserved. He came as our Savior to bring peace, that peace which worldly things cannot give. He brings peace to the troubled and the weary. The peace that Jesus brings is truly lasting and satisfying. This Christmas let us all remember to share that peace with someone we may know or meet.

Finally, Jesus comes to show us the glories of his righteousness. We cannot live the perfect righteous life. Jesus came to show us the perfect life and to live it in our stead. We can model our lives after him and with the aid of the Holy Spirit walk in his footsteps. Do you have trouble living your life for him? When you fail, don't give up, but be thankful that he has forgiven those failings and helps you to live anew for him.

For the real joy of Christmas, let Jesus come into your home and life. Make room for him and you will be amazed at His love. The wonders of his love are truly transforming.
