

BIBLE READING PLAN

FOR THE WEEK OF March 4, 2017

MONDAY – 1 John 1:1-4

Why is it important that John and others heard, saw, and touched Jesus, and didn't just relate a story someone else told?

What does fellowship look like with God? With others?

Overall, how is your Christian community? What would make it better?

TUESDAY – 1 John 1:5-10

How does your faith in Jesus change your view of sin? Is it possible to have faith in God and continue living in sin? Why or why not?

What does it mean to "walk in the light as He is in the light?"

Describe how living in the light aids in purification.

WEDNESDAY – 1 John 2:1-6

Does knowing that Jesus speaks to the Father on our behalf encourage you to seek him when you sin? Why or why not? What does it mean to KNOW God? How has knowing Him changed you?

THURSDAY – 1 John 2:7-11

Why do you think John emphasizes LOVE as much as he does? (See Jn 17)

How does participating in community (or not) affect your faith?

What do you think the THEME of this book might be?

FRIDAY – 1 John 2:12-17

What is your reaction to the statement: "Do not love the world or the things in the world"? How does John describe "love for the world?" Which of these do you struggle with? How does it affect your relationship with God?

SATURDAY – 1 John 2:18-27

What does your relationship with the Church say about you? What do you learn about false teachers in this passage? Has there ever been a time in your life when the Holy Spirit made you aware of false teaching?
