Call for Student Presentations!

*Would you like to present at the 46th Annual MSRC state meeting?
Represent your school and the profession!*

The Missouri Society for Respiratory Care recognizes that Missouri Respiratory schools represent some of the best programs and students in the country. As such, we wish to show case our outstanding students at the MSRC annual state meeting!

Students will be given an opportunity to present their academic work during the student breakout session at the state meeting. Presenters will be awarded complimentary registration to the state meeting (or reimbursement of registration fees for those students who pay registration as part of their program tuition) and a small honorarium for their time. This will make an EXCELLENT addition to your resume!

Presentation Details

- Selected students will give a formal podium presentation during the student breakout session.
- Presentations should be 10-12 minutes in length and will be followed by 2-3 minutes of Q&A from the audience.
- Each presentation should be in PowerPoint format, with no more than 20 slides. Slide design/background is at the discretion of the student.
- References should be cited within the body of the presentation or on a separate reference slide.

Presentation Content

The content of each presentation should be relevant to the profession of respiratory care. This may be work that the student completed as part of a class, research project, research paper, etc. 2015 topics included: Tracheoesophageal Fistula, Fetal Alcohol Syndrome, ARDS: Recruitment Maneuvers and Prone Positioning, and Bronchopulmonary Dysplasia.

Requirements for speakers

In order to be considered for inclusion in the MSRC annual State meeting program, students must:

- Be a current student, in good standing, at an accredited Missouri Respiratory Care Program
- Be a student member of the AARC
- Request that their program director write a letter to the education committee chair in support of the student's application to speak. This letter must also include a statement from the director allowing the student to miss coursework/classes in order to attend the state meeting/conference.

Selection Process

Students must complete and submit an application to the MSRC Education Committee Chair by **February 3, 2017** in order to be considered. The committee chair, working with our current student liaisons, will make final presenter selections.

Applications must be received by February 2, 2017 for consideration.
