Opening Statement

Order of Business

(Call for relays; handle emergency traffic immediately)
- Are there any QST or bulletin listings?
(Check for events on the calendar. Announce immediately)
- Are there any traffic or contact listings for the San Joaquin Net?
- Are there any member mobiles or stations on emergency power? Please come with your numbers and call letters. *(Call for relays; handle traffic immediately)*
- Are there any necessary early member check-ins? Please come with your numbers and call letters. *(Call for relays)*
- San Joaquin Net Roll Call follows: *(Use Monthly Roll Call sheet)*
- This is _____, Net Control. Now open for late or missed members.
- The Net is now open for visitor check-ins. *(Call for relays)*
- *Handle: (1) Message form traffic; (2) Contacts (limit: 3 minutes if on frequency, or move off frequency)*
