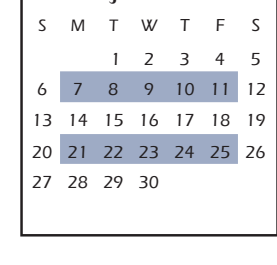
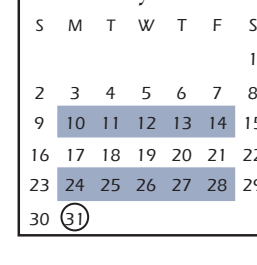
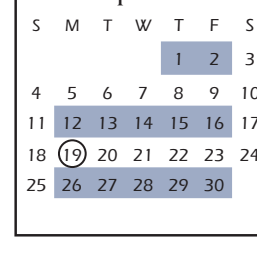
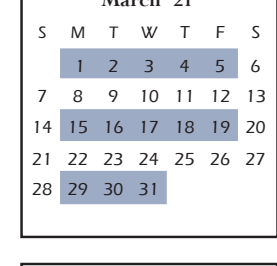
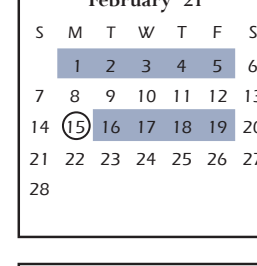
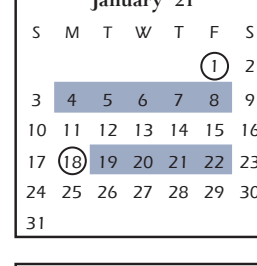
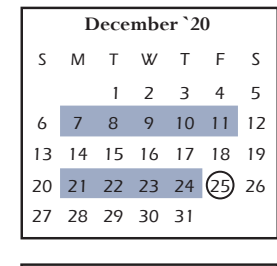
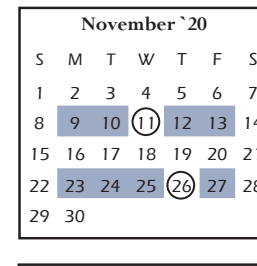
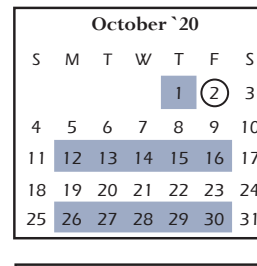
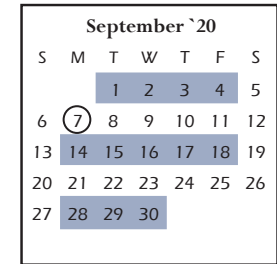
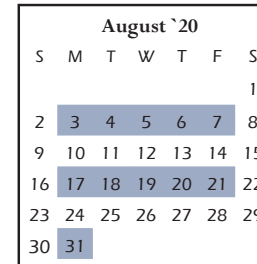
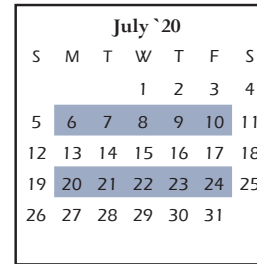
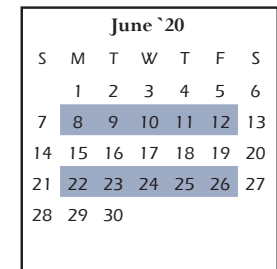
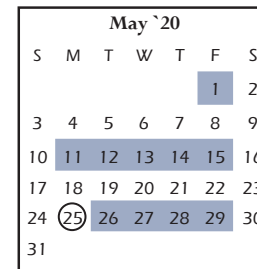
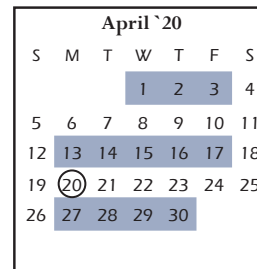
Whenever a scheduled collection day falls on a holiday, that day's collection and all remaining collections for the week will be delayed one day. Friday's collection will be on Saturday.

For residents living in 1-4 unit homes with municipal trash collection  
Seasonal Curbside Yard Waste Collection Weeks

- ◆ Yard Waste is collected during the weeks of:  
2019 11/4-11/8, 11/18-11/22  
2020 5/11-5/15, 11/2-11/6, 11/16-11/20  
2021 5/10-5/14



- ◆ Place leaves, grass, wood chips and all other easily raked material in paper yard waste bags at curbside by 7am on your normal trash collection day during Yard Waste Collection Weeks.
- ◆ Brush (3" x 3' or smaller) is no longer picked up at curbside. It is now chipped at drop-off Center.
- ◆ Contact the Department of Public Works at (978) 897-1317 for information on backyard composting.

*Important Information on other side*

The Town of Maynard has automated curbside collection of single stream recycling. The entire towns recycling will be picked up every other week. Additional carts may be purchased by calling E.L. Harvey. No separation of material is needed, i.e. glass, paper and plastic. All material must be in the cart to be collected and the cart must be curbside away from trash, mailboxes, etc.

**Regular Trash** – Trash is collected every week  
Every bag or barrel (up to 32 gallons or 38 lbs.) of trash set out for trash collection must have a sticker tag(s) on the bag or on the top item in the barrel, in order to be collected. There are 2 choices in sticker tags depending on the volume/weight set out:  
Bags or barrels up to 15gal./38lbs. require a PINK sticker tag - cost of \$1.00  
Bags or barrels up to 32 gal./38lbs. require a YELLOW sticker tag - cost of \$2.00

**HELPFUL HINTS:**  
• Use the right sticker tag • buy sticker tags ahead • You'll need them weekly • 2 Pink=1 Yellow

- ◆ The Department of Public Works strictly enforces the 32-gallon barrel rule. Trash left at the curb in barrels larger than 32 gallons will not be picked up. If a 32-gallon barrel is used to consolidate loose remodeling debris, it can not weigh more than 39lbs.
- ◆ Large items-Objects that weigh less than 39 pounds, or up to three feet long will be collected only if \$10 worth of sticker tags are attached. Examples are sofas, mattresses, doors, etc. Mattresses and boxsprings \$10.00 stickers for each piece.
- ◆ 32 gallon barrels of trash, must be filled only to the level where a cover if applied would fit. Over filled barrels will be left at curbside. Put sticker tag on top item in barrel.
- ◆ Do not place sticker tag on barrel.
- ◆ In cold weather sticker tags don't stick well to cold bags, so, stick the sticker tag to a warm bag, or to itself wrapped around drawing or bag neck.

- Aluminum/in/steel cans colors & sizes
- Glass bottles/jars, all

**PAPER CONTAINERS**

- Junk Mail
- Office Paper
- Milk Cartons and juice dishes, glasses, Pyrex, items (e.g. window glass, NO broken glass or other
- Aseptic juice boxes
- Phone books
- Brown paper bags
- NO waste paper, plastic coated paper or plastic cans or bottles
- NO ceramic, light bulbs)
- NO hazardous materials or hazardous materials
