Middleton Junior Earns Top ACT Score!

Congratulations to Middleton Engineering Magnet Student, Varun Singh, for earning the **highest possible ACT Composite score of 36!** This achievement on the ACT is significant and rare. On average, less than one-tenth of 1% of all test takers earns the top score. Among ACT-tested US high school graduates in the class of 2015, only 1,598 out of 1.92 million students earned an ACT Composite score of 36. Varun, you make us proud!!



Middleton Robotics Takes 1st Place at State Championships



Middleton's own Team "Masquerade 4997" placed **FIRST at the Florida FTC State Robotics Championships** on Saturday, February 13, 2016, at St. Leo's University! The best 28 FTC teams in Florida competed. (There are 170 FTC teams in Florida.) Masquerade also set a new FTC World Record with <u>534 pts</u> scored in a match - see world record match on <u>YouTube</u>!
