
Once you have watched the story discuss the following with your child:

- Why did the billy goats want to cross the river?
- How do you think they felt when the troll popped up from underneath the bridge?
- Watch the story again and encourage your child to join in with "trip trap trip trap" and "who's that crossing my bridge?"

At home you could have a go at using different materials to make bridges.



You could try using different materials such as straws, lego or dry spaghetti and see which one makes the strongest bridge.




Can your child think of any other materials they could use?


